- ◆ be affiliated with a formal student-internship program sponsored by an accredited college or university;
- ◆ be approved by their program or major field of study to participate in an internship;
- ◆ possess a positive, “roll-up-your-sleeves” attitude and be a team player!

### Counseling / Caseworker

Internships are available year-round at all our county locations.

Undergraduate and Master's-level internships in counseling or as a caseworker require enrollment in related majors or programs such as:

- ◆ counseling
- ◆ psychology
- ◆ social work
- ◆ human services

Depending upon level of education, interns receive experience in Catholic Charities' Family Therapy, Pregnancy and Parenting, Homeless, Refugee Services, and/or Outreach Assistance programs.
